We are working on Plugging the Guard #1 (05-123-12864), Document #403355309. We tagged the CIBP higher than it was originally set. It was supposed to be set @ 7,090', and we tagged @ 6,774'. The TOC is at 6,246', so we are within the cement. The next step is to perforate and squeeze up hole. Just wanting to make sure we are good to move up hole to complete the plugging.
