## DETAILS OF WORK

The well was plugged December 20th, 1957 by filling it with heavy mud from the total depth to the bottom of the surface pipe (4951 to 175). A 10 sack cement plug was set in the bottom 30 feet of the surface pipe 175 to 145, then the casing was filled with heavy mud to within 20 feet of the top. A 7 sack cement plug was set in the top 20 feet of the surface pipe (33 to 11).

All measurements are taken from the kelly bushing which was approximately 9 feet above the ground.
