This location is within or close proximity to a Parks & Wildlife (CPW) District with High Priority, NSO, Density, and Other Consultation Habitat regulations.

Follow up inspection in response to compliance issues observed during Insp. #715500526 on 8/6/24. Tank battery sign and tank label have been installed. The following Corrective Actions are still unresolved and original due dates remain:

1. Debris.
