W. H. Coltharp "B" 1 was completed on 6-16-48 to a total depth of 6322. Top of Weber at 5812 with 7" casing set at 5815. Initial production was 212 BOPD pumping. Production declined to 96 BOPD and well was Hydrafraced in December 1949. 3 zones were Hydrafraced and 3 zones oil squeezed. On test October, 1950 well pumped 75 BOPD. It is intended to selectively oil squeeze entire producing section in 25' intervals using Halliburton H-40 Packer and 4 Halliburton pump trucks.
