Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands: Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

W. H. Coltharp B-1 was selectively oil squeezed on November 30, 1950 using an H-40 Hydraulic Straddle Packer with a 25 ft. spacing. The entire length of open hole was squeezed in 25 ft. intervals from 5861 to 6300; 12 zones being treated using 3 trucks to inject crude oil into the formation. Injection pressures ranged from 1600 to 2600 psi. and injection rates from 4 to 5.9 bbls. per min. An average of 75 bbls. was injected into each zone. Production was increased from 70 to 149 BOPD.
