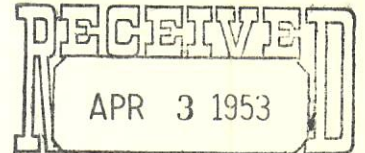

Stanolind purposes to shoot and clean out subject well as follows:

1. Move in rig, pull rods, tag bottom and pull tubing. Cleanout to TD with reverse circulation.
2. Run Lane Wells Radioactivity Log from TD to 5550'.
3. Shoot with 745.4 quarts SNG from 6261' to 5704' (Subject to correlation ~~km~~ of Radioactivity Log.) A 3 yard gravel tamp and 24 hours bomb will be used.
4. Cleanout well after shot and put on production.
