Mr Zimbelman,

As we discussed on the phone a couple of days ago, we need to get in to the old ZIMBELMAN 2-B well location to do some additional down hole work. I have attached an aerial of the location. The first step is we need to have one of our personnel come out on site and locate exact location of the old well, using a magnetometer. That would be occurring probably as soon as they can get it scheduled. This shouldn't tear up the ground at all.

When they are ready to begin work at the well, we would need access from the road in to the location, then set up a workover rig/equipment at the site. Work site size is 150' each direction from the well head, a little over 2 acres. Where would be the best place for us to access the location?

Anticipated time on site would be 5-7 days. After the equipment is moved back out, the ground will be restored back in time for your planting.

As discussed, the work is currently scheduled to begin in early March and completed by March 13. If needed, I can try to get that moved up a bit, to avoid the fertilizing we were discussing.
