## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to ECMC Rule 911 a site investigation was conducted pertaining to the HAGEMEISTER USX AA07-01 wellhead cut and cap and flowline removal. The entire length of the flowline was abandoned-in-place per landowner agreement. The ECMC will be updated in a supplemental Form 27 if any portion of the flowline is able to be removed. The wellhead was cut and capped per ECMC rules. Additionally, soil samples were field screened at the N-E-S-W sides of the wellhead. Soil samples were taken at the start and endpoint of the flowline. The Form 44 abandonment number is 404050667.

Please note that a sample was collected from beneath the flowline riser at the separator during decommissioning activities at the former Hagemeister USX AA-66N63W 7NWNE Tank Battery (REM# 36558).

## PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

### Proposed Soil Sampling

Will soil samples be collected as part of this investigation? ( Number, type (grab/composite), analyses, and locations of samples ):

A grab soil sample was collected at the base of the excavation or the area showing the highest degree of impact during field screening activities at the wellhead excavation. Additionally, soil samples were field screened at the N-E-S-W sides of the wellhead. Soil samples were taken at the start and endpoint of the flowline where the area exists. Soil samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for the full extent of Table 915-1, including but not limited to: TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons) organic compounds in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, and EC, SAR, pH, metals, and boron. All samples collected were analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved ECMC laboratory analysis methods.

### Proposed Groundwater Sampling

Will groundwater samples be collected as part of this investigation? ( Number, analyses, and locations of samples ):

If groundwater is encountered during the site investigation a grab groundwater will be collected and analyzed for all organic and inorganic compounds per ECMC Table 915-1; this sample analysis includes, but is not limited to BTEX, naphthalene, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene (TMB), and 1,3,5-TMB by EPA Method 8260, chloride and sulfate anions by EPA Method 300.0, and total dissolved solids (TDS) by Method SM 2540C.

Visual inspection of the wellhead and flowline areas occurred during abandonment activities. Field personnel field screened all disturbed areas using visual and olfactory senses to determine if laboratory confirmation sampling was required. A detailed summary of flowline decommissioning activities, including field notes, site photos, figures, and laboratory analytical results, is attached to this Form 27.

One background soil sample (BKG01-FL@4') was collected near the flowline and analyzed for metals in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, pH, EC, SAR, and boron. The background soil sample was collected from a depth of 4 feet below ground surface. The maximum background concentrations for pH, SAR, and EC were observed to be 8.57, 7.31, and 1.75mmhos/cm respectively. The maximum background concentrations with a 1.25x multiplier applied for arsenic was calculated to be 3.65mg/kg.

A supplemental site investigation (SSI) will be completed to vertically and horizontally delineate the pH, EC, and SAR exceedances observed during decommissioning. A proposed soil boring location map is attached to this Form 27. During the SSI, soil samples will be collected and analyzed for full ECMC Table 915-1 constituents. Concurrently with the SSI, additional background samples will be collected to determine if arsenic, pH, EC, and SAR are attributed to native soil conditions at the site. The background soil samples will be analyzed for full ECMC Table 915-1 metals, pH, EC, SAR, and boron. The SSI will be completed in accordance with the proposed implementation schedule, and the results of the SSI will be submitted on a subsequent Form 27.

One background soil sample (BKG01-FL@4') was collected near the flowline and analyzed for metals in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, pH, EC, SAR, and boron. The background soil sample was collected from a depth of 4 feet below ground surface. The maximum background concentrations for pH, SAR, and EC were observed to be 8.57, 7.31, and 1.75mmhos/cm respectively. The maximum background concentrations with a 1.25x multiplier applied for arsenic was calculated to be 3.65mg/kg.

The flowline riser at the separator (SEP01-FL@4') was sampled during decommissioning of the associated Hagemeister USX AA-66N63W 7NWNE Tank Battery (REM# 36558), and all further reporting for this sample will be under this project.

Quarterly reporting will be conducted until closure criteria are achieved for the remediation project. The results of the supplemental site investigation will be submitted on a subsequent Form 27.
