Dear Mr. Rogers

The Application for Permit to Drill the subject well was approved December 20, 1972; however, due to adverse weather condition and the shortage of drilling rigs we have been unable to get this well scheduled and will not be able to commence drilling operations prior to April 19, 1973, the expiration date of the 120-day approval period.

We now have a rig scheduled to start drilling in Colorado on or about April 8, 1973, but an April lease expiration date on the Pfeifer #1, Permit No. 73156, compels us to drill this well first. The subject location would be drilled immediately following the Pfeifer #1.

Based on the above, I hereby request that the approval period be extended an additional 30-days.
