- An excavation remains open at the spill location with the separator having been removed since the Initial Supplement Spill/Release report (Form 19 Document No. 404051616; 1/8/2025).
- Orange construction fencing surrounds the excavation.
- The liner was observed to be cut for excavation and stained soil was visible in situ beneath the depth of the liner.

Comment: An excavation remains open at the spill location with the separator having been removed since previous inspection (Field Inspection Form Document No. 718200003; 1/6/2025). The liner was observed to be cut for excavation and stained soil was visible in situ beneath the depth of the liner; therefore, the spill cannot be considered contained within secondary containment. The date of discovery for the release was reported as 1/3/2025 and Operator stated, "A waste characterization was collected on 1/7/2025," on Initial/Supplement Spill/Release report (Form 19 Document No. 404051616; 1/8/2025). ECMC does not consider impacted soil exposed at the surface and collected four days after the date of discovery representative of waste.

Corrective Action: Operator shall clarify where and how the waste characterization sample was collected, and update the status of containment on the next Supplemental Form 19. A Form 19 Supplemental Report which requests closure of Spill ID 488967 is due by 4/3/2025.
