INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to COGCC Rule 911 a site investigation will be conducted pertaining to the CHEWY B23-25 wellhead cut and cap and flowline removal. Approximately 275' of flowline will be removed if present. The wellhead was capped per ECMC rules per DOC 402397106.

PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

Proposed Soil Sampling

Will soil samples be collected as part of this investigation? (Number, type (grab/composite), analyses, and locations of samples):

Grab soil samples will be screened and collected at the base of the excavation or the area showing the highest degree of impact during field screening activities. Additionally, soil samples will be screened and collected at the N-E-S-W sides of the former wellhead. Additionally, soil samples will be screened and sampled along the flowline at any points of material change and/or hammer unions, directional changes, as well as at the bell holes on either side of a waterway. Lastly, background samples will be collected from soil of similar lithographic material to further compare ECMC Table 915-1 COCs. All soil samples will be analyzed by a certified laboratory for ECMC Table 915-1 COCs. All samples collected will be analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved ECMC laboratory analytical methods.

The ECMC Flowline Closure and Wellhead Closure Checklists will be utilized and filled out during the abandonment process. A photolog will be submitted on the Subsequent Form 27.

The Operator is in the process of scheduling excavation activities, pending site access. Additional site investigation for sampling beyond the proposed sampling area will be completed and addressed on a subsequent quarterly form 27 submittals.

An investigation of UPRC-65N64W Tank Battery (Rem 22296) is detailed in Doc.#404101474.

An investigation of UPRC 23-15H4, UPRC 23-11H4 and the Flowline System (Rem 17606) is detailed in Doc.#404090427.

UPRC 23-10H4 was plugged and abandoned on 8/17/16 as detailed in Doc.#401115574; however, information regarding investigation and remediation activities could not be identified. Additional information on this well will be addressed on a subsequent form 27 submittal.
