Good afternoon, Jessica,

As previously indicated and based on ECMC's inspection the depth to shallow groundwater is approximately 15' below ground surface (bgs).

We have determined the following after review of the Division of Water Resources (DWR) records for your water well:

- Distance to water well from the Spill/Release point; approximately 440' south to southwest;
- Approximate depth of water well, 480' bgs;
- Screened interval of the water well, 410'- 480' bgs; and
- Static groundwater (depth to groundwater your well is completed in); 250' bgs.

Based on this information, ECMC does not anticipate impacts to your water well as a result of the Spill/Release. However, ECMC can sample the water well to provide additional assurance if you'd like. Please let us know and we will make arrangements for that to be done.

Good afternoon, Jessica,

Groundwater appears to have infiltrated the base of the excavation. During our inspection yesterday Grace Rollins (cc'd here) and I noted a strong hydrocarbon odor, free product on groundwater and black stained soil in contact with groundwater within the open excavation. KPK will be required to collect groundwater samples and install monitoring wells to assess and determine the extent of impacts to groundwater in addition to soil.
