
NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT

Gentlemen:

The Derby Dome Corporation has now ceased to operate and the Corporation dissolved. The wells in the $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$, $S.W.\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.2 T3S Eange 66W are being abandoned as oil and gas explorations.

Applications to the Water Conservation Commission for permission to convert these wells to water wells are enclosed. The wells revert to the land owners who are also officers of the Corporation. If these applications are approved, it is requested that a release from the bond on the plugging of the wells be issued. Incidentally no ground water was encountered and the wells are cased with new casing below the levels at which any water was encountered, and were filled with 100 pound mud.
