

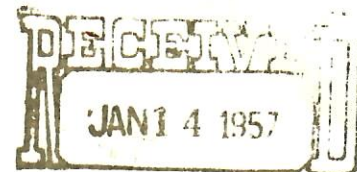

Some time ago your office made inquiry regarding the disposition of Piceance Creek Unit Wells Nos. 27X-7 (Sec. 7, T. 3S., R. 95W.), 66X-18 (Sec. 18, T. 3S., R. 95W.), and 77X-13 (Sec. 13, T. 3S., R. 96W.).

Notices of intention to drill these wells were filed with the U.S.G.S. on May 8, 1956, and were approved by Mr. G. G. Frazier on May 10, 1956. These wells were not drilled and the locations were abandoned. Approval of the deletion of these locations from the 1956 Plan of Development was secured from the U.S.G.S. on December 7, 1956. These three locations can therefore be dropped from your records.
