The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 6739 ft.


DETAILS OF WORK

6/27 to 6/30 Plugged from 2651' to 2608' w/ 22 sac cement and 2 sac Calceol. Ran packer on 2-7/8" tubing. Set packer @ 2543'.

6/30 Drilled P.L. to 2543'. Supplied every hour for 25 hours.

7/2 Recovered and treated 1 1/2 bbl. salt water per hour. Well flowed gas for 9 1/2 hours at 2543' and 2541' pressure. Killed well with water.
