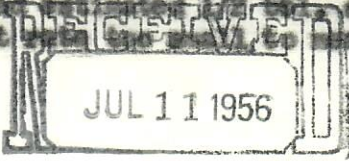
DETAILS OF WORK

6/30 Drilled P.L. to 2543'. Spudded every hour for 25 hours.

7/2 Recovered estimated 1 1/2 bbl. salt water per hour. Well flowed gas for 9 1/2 hours at 2543' to measure. Killed well with water.
