Dear Mr. Rogers:

As per our recent discussion, Exeter intends to formally request permission for an underground disposal facility to dispose of produced water from the following wells operated by Exeter:

- NE/SE 15 - #1 Propst
- ✓ SE/NE 15 - State Propst
- NE/NE 15 - State Propst
- SE/SE 10 - #1 State Warren

There had previously been another producing well in the field located in the SE/SE 15, which was temporarily abandoned several years ago and it is this cased hole that we intend to use for the disposal facility.

As you are undoubtedly aware, all of these wells produce or produced from the "J" sand. Therefore, one of the natural injection strata could be the "J" sand. If injection were to be done on a permanent basis into the "J" sand, however, either a unitization or agreement of owners in the field would be necessary. We would appreciate at this time your permission for short duration injectivity tests to be allowed into the "J" sand so that we may evaluate that horizon's relative merits for permanent injection.



We should mention that the proposed injection well also has a "D" sand section that is prospective for injection. We may, at a later date, request that permission be granted for injectivity test into this zone also in as much as certain unitization requirements could be circumvented if permanent disposal were made into the "D" sand.
