RE: Disposition of Flowlines within the Southeast Campo Unit
T34S & T35S, R45W & 46W, Baca County, Colorado

To Ms. LaPointe,

Murfin Drilling Company, Inc. ("Murfin") is the operator of the Southeast Campo Unit, located in Baca County, Colorado. Murfin is in the process of plugging the remaining wells within the unit and decommissioning the surface equipment and flowlines.

Per your latest email, the USFS has indicated a desire to leave the flowlines in place "to limit surface disturbance in the cattle grazing pasture of that area."

Murfin will follow all abandonment in place requirements as outlined in 1105.e as shown below. A link to the entire rule section can be found at <https://ecmc.state.co.us/reg.html#/rules>.

1105.e. Abandonment in place requirements. For a flowline or crude oil transfer line abandoned in place, the operator must: (1). Evacuate the flowline or crude oil transfer line of any hydrocarbons or produced water to ensure the line is safe and inert; (2). Deplete the flowline or crude oil transfer line to atmospheric pressure; (3). Cut the flowline's or crude oil transfer line's risers to three (3) feet below grade or to the depth of the flowline or crude oil transfer line, whichever is shallower; (4). Seal the ends of the flowline or crude oil transfer line below grade; (5). Remove above-ground cathodic protection and equipment associated with the riser; and (6). Include pressure test results conducted in the prior 12 months as well as identification of any document numbers for a COGCC Spill/Release Report, Form 19, associated with the abandoned line with the Flowline Report, Form 44, submitted pursuant to Rule 1105.f.(2); and (7). For an off-location flowline or crude oil transfer line abandoned in place pursuant to Rule 1105.d.(2), the operator must submit documentation supporting the applicable reason for abandonment in place with the Flowline Report, Form 44, submitted pursuant to Rule 1105.f.(2)
