Subject: notice to BLM of intent to abandon registered flowlines in place at the Maudlin Gulch field

Mr. Barrett;

This email provides the Colorado Energy and Carbon Management Commission (ECMC) required notification for the planned abandonment in place of all the remaining registered flowlines at the Maudlin Gulch field in Moffat County.

The registered flowlines tied to the following wells on property owned by the federal government that are included in this notification include the following;

- Maudlin Gulch #2 well
- Maudlin Gulch #27 well
- Maudlin Gulch #4 well
- Maudlin Gulch #18 well
- Maudlin Gulch #22R well
- Stroock NCT 1-1 well

Also included in this notification is the in place abandonment of any other associated registered flowlines that are present between headers or otherwise in the area of these wells.

The Form 44 (ECMC document # 403967596) submitted to the ECMC describes the planned abandonment work in detail.

This work is being completed as part of the plugging and abandonment of the entire Maudlin Gulch field. A single Form 44 (ECMC document # 403967596) has been submitted to the ECMC regarding this planned work.

This work is scheduled to be started on or about July 1st, 2025 but may not be completed until August 31st, 2025.

If you have any questions, comments, or objections to the planned in place abandonment work, you are required to provide your comments to the ECMC within 15 days of this notification. My contact for this Form 44 work with the ECMC is listed below.
