Pursuant to our conversation please find below a summary of the site-specific stormwater BMPs for the D & C and Production phases of development, along with the Will Serve Letter approval criteria.

Drilling Completion Phase

During the drilling completion phase, several stormwater management measures are implemented to control erosion, sediment, and runoff on the site. Slope Intercept Ditches (SIDs) are constructed along the perimeter on the north, south, and east sides downstream to capture and remove sediment before it leaves the site. Onsite conveyance swales are built on the east and west sides of the pad to collect drainage and direct it to an Extended Detention Basin (EDB) located on the southern side of the pad. Two culverts are installed beneath the access road: one conveying western offsite flows along historic drainage paths without detention, and the other directing both offsite and pad drainage through the detention pond. Diversion berms are strategically placed along western cut slopes to reroute offsite runoff back on-site, maintaining historic flow patterns. Temporary inlet protections (IPs) and outlet protections (OPs) are also installed at culvert inlets, slope drains, and conduit outlets to prevent sediment from entering stormwater infrastructure.

Production Phase

In the production phase, stormwater controls continue with modifications reflecting the site's evolving conditions during interim reclamation. Conveyance swales remain on the west side of the pad to capture drainage and channel it to the detention pond, with ongoing erosion and sediment management through Best Management Practices (BMPs). Slope Intercept Ditches continue to be placed on the north, south, and east downstream boundaries to intercept any sediment before it leaves the site. Diversion berms maintain their role in directing water flows around the pad, preserving the historic offsite flow patterns. The two culverts installed during drilling remain operational, facilitating drainage and flow into the detention pond and spillway. The Extended Detention Basin is maintained to collect sediment and debris, requiring periodic cleaning to ensure continued effectiveness. Inlet and outlet protections are sustained to protect stormwater infrastructure during this phase.

Pursuant to your request regarding the approval of the site-specific ERP by Bennett-Watkins Fire and Rescue (BWFR) please find attached a portions of the e-mail correspondence with Victoria Flamini the Fire Marshall, noting the materials provided to her to make her determination to sign/approve the Will Serve Letter indicating BWFR's agreement to provide emergency services to the location (Site Plan, ERP-TRP, and Fire Mitigation Plan). Please let us know if you need any further information to satisfy this requirement.
