## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to ECMC Rule 911 a site investigation was conducted pertaining to the STATE 16-13 wellhead cut and cap. The wellhead was cut and capped per ECMC rules. The flowline was previously abandoned on 4/11/1970.

One grab confirmation soil sample was collected at the wellhead excavation. Soil samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for full extent per ECMC Table 915-1, EC, SAR, pH, and boron. One waste characterization soil sample was collected for ECMC Table 915-1 metals analysis. All samples collected were analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved ECMC laboratory analysis methods.

A background sample was collected during initial investigation 10 March 2023 Background-01 at a depth of 3ft bgs. The sample was collected from similar lithologic soil near the wellhead for ECOM Table 915-1 metals (sans Cr VI) analysis.

Three additional samples were collected during delineation sampling on 28 May 2025 at a depth of 6ft bgs. The sample were collected from soil of native/similar lithologic material not impacted by oil and gas activity. Background samples were analyzed for ECOM Table 915-1 SSR and metals. The pH, SAR and EC were within ECOM Table 915-1 standards. The samples had detections for Arsenic ranging from 0.994 to 1.04 mg/kg, no other metals were above standards.

The 1-Methyl-Naphthalene observed at sample locations WH-01, will be removed through remedial excavation. Operator will conduct supplement source mass removal (SSMR) excavation activities and will sample excavation boundaries in accordance with ECME standards. All samples collected will be analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved ECOM laboratory analysis methods.

This SF27 serves as a 3Q2025 quarterly update for STATE 16-13 (REM 26953).

Operator performed confirmational and further delineation soil sampling on 28 May 2025 based on previous field analytical results at WH-FS-01, WH-SS-01, and WH-SS-02. Confirmation samples were analyzed for the full ECMC Table 915-1 analytical list with additional background samples not impacted by oil and gas activity analyzed for SSR and metals. Analytical data is currently under review and will be provided on a subsequent form submittal, along with a proposed path forward.

Pursuant to Rule 913.e, quarterly reporting will be conducted until closure criteria are achieved for the remediation project. Results of the supplemental site investigation and source mass removal activities will be submitted on a subsequent Form 27.
