This Warning Letter is to inform you that DCP OPERATING COMPANY LP (“Operator”) may be in violation of the rules and regulations of the Colorado Energy and Carbon Management Commission (“ECMC”) and corrective action is required.

ECMC has reasonable cause to believe that Operator has committed one or more violations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, or of a rule, regulation, or order of the Commission, or of a permit issued by the Commission. Operator is required to comply with this Warning Letter by the **Corrective Action Deadline Date(s)** to resolve the alleged violation(s). Failure to do so will result in the issuance of a Notice of Alleged Violation and initiation of enforcement proceedings in which ECMC will seek monetary penalties for the alleged violations pursuant to § 34-60-121, C.R.S. and Rule 525, ECMC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1.

Alleged Violation(s) and Required Corrective Action(s):

207. Reports

Violation Date: 07/23/2025

Violation Discovery Date: 07/23/2025

Description of Alleged Violation: Pursuant to 207 any report required under the Commission’s Rules or requested by the Director or the Commission will be timely filed, accurate, complete, and comply with the requirements set forth in the Commission’s Rules or any requirement set by the Director or the Commission.

On May 27, 2025, DCP Operating Company, LP (“Operator”) submitted a Form 27 Remediation Workplan (Document No 404180053) for CR55/CR4 (AT-1-1-1-1-6-3) 5/2023 Spill (Spill ID 484701, Remediation Number 31076) proposing four additional delineation of monitoring wells at the location. Staff denied the Form 27 on July 09, 2025 as the delineation plan was inadequate to characterize the plume as required by Rule 912.b.(2). The Operator was directed to propose at least six additional wells via a replacement Supplemental Form 27 for Remediation Project by July 23, 2025.

On July 23, 2025 Operator submitted a replacement Form 27 (Document No 404287892) proposing a total of three delineation monitoring wells. ECMC denied this form on July 29, 2025 as it did not comply with the previous Staff directive or Rule 912.b.(2). Operator was directed to submit a replacement form

with the required additional wells immediately.

As of August 13, 2025, Operator has not submitted a Supplemental Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan Remediation that complies with Rule 912.b.(2) for Project Number 31076.

Operator failed to provide the requested plan to adequately characterize the impacts in compliance with Rule 912.b.(2), violating Rule 207.

Required Corrective Action: Operator shall submit a Supplemental Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan for Remediation Project Number 31076 as required by denial comments on Document number 404287892.

Corrective Action Deadline Date: 08/14/2025
