The near bank is incised 2.0 to 2.5 feet, so temporary fills must be placed to establish a stable and safe work area. The fill will be comprised of natural topsoil from another nearby project location (and will be returned to that location following this project). Mats (or equivalent) will be placed in the washout area prior to the placement of fill, and concrete jersey barriers will be placed along the edge of the lined fill. The fill, barriers, and mats will all be removed following completion of this operation, restoring the area to its current condition.</p> <p>The creek is currently dry and unsuitable for most aquatic native species. RPG Resources conducted an assessment of the washout area and confirmed it does not meet USACE wetland criteria. Crestone (Civitas) is working with RPG Resources to submit all necessary paperwork and permit documentation to the USACE and CDPHE to ensure compliance with all requirements related to the temporary dirt fill work. Standard Stormwater/SPCC protocols will also be followed.</p>
