INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to ECMC Rule 911, a site investigation was conducted pertaining to the UNI UPR C25-06 wellhead cut and cap and flowline abandonment. The wellhead was cut and capped per ECMC rules on 05/25/23. Details associated with the wellhead cut and cap are outlined in Form 27 #403565302 submitted 10/18/23. The flowline was previously abandoned in place on 07/05/23, per Form 44 #403515255. The entire flowline (approximately 1,908') was removed on 02/12/24, per Form 44 #403770294. Laboratory samples were collected from beneath the flowline riser at the wellhead (FL01-A@4') and the separator (FL01-B@3.5') and at directional changes (FL01-D@3' and FL01-E@4'). Additionally, field screening samples (FL01-C@3', FL01-F@4' - FL01-K@3') were collected at any points of material change and/or hammer unions, or directional changes.

Analytical results indicated that organic compound concentrations were below Table 915-1 in all confirmation soil samples collected. Groundwater was not encountered during the wellhead or flowline decommissioning.

Soil samples were collected as described in the Initial Action Summary of this Form 27. All sampling was conducted in accordance with the Initial Form 27 # 403005902. Soil samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons) organic compounds in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, pH, EC, SAR, boron and metals.

A supplemental site investigation (SSI) will be completed to demonstrate full ECMC Table 915-1 compliance at the wellhead cut and cap excavation sample location WH-FS-01@6' and wellhead flowline riser sample location FL01-A@4'. The proposed soil sampling locations are shown on the proposed SSI map attached to Form 27 # 404174491. Confirmation soil samples collected from the wellhead cut and cap excavation area will be submitted for laboratory analysis of the full ECMC Table 915-1 analytical suite. Concurrently with the SSI, background samples will be collected to determine if inorganics and metals are attributed to native soil conditions at the site. Background soil samples will be collected and analyzed for metals in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, pH, EC, SAR, and boron. The SSI will be completed in accordance with the proposed implementation schedule, and the results of the SSI will be submitted on a subsequent Form 27.

In addition, the pH exceedance identified at the separator flowline riser (FL01-B@3.5') sampled during the removal of the UNI UPR C25-06 Flowline will be remediated under the UNI UPR C25-04 SSI, under ECMC Remediation Project No. 27960. Any additional remedial activities will be conducted under the Remediation Project Number aforementioned. Results of the SSI will be provided on subsequent Form 27.
