Dear Mr. Nicklas:

It is our understanding that you desire to take over the Vessels & Strain No. 1 Nicklas well located in the NW NW, Section 30, Township 9 North, Range 55 West, Logan County, Colorado. We have no objection to your doing this, but there are certain requirements which first must be met.

In order to relieve S. D. Johnson from future additional plugging of the well, we must have a letter from you relieving him from such obligation.

For your information, we have been advised that the well was sanded and a 5-sack cement plug placed across and above perforations (5660 to 5667) and that the casing was shot but they were unable to pull it. However, 600' of the 4 1/2" casing was recovered at a later date, and it is currently reported that the top of the 4 1/2" casing is at 638' below ground level, and that there is 106' of 3-5/8" casing in the hole.

We are enclosing application for use of ground water forms which must be submitted to the State Engineer's Office, Room 232, State Services Building, 1525 Sherman, Denver 3, Colorado.

Your prompt attention to the above matters will be appreciated, and upon their receipt and the receipt of other forms needed on the well from S. D. Johnson, that organization will be relieved of future plugging.
