## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to ECMC Rule 911 a site investigation will be conducted pertaining to the CHEWY B23-25 wellhead cut and cap and flowline removal. Approximately 275' of flowline will be removed if present. The wellhead was capped per ECMC rules per DOC 402397106.

## PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

### Proposed Soil Sampling

Will soil samples be collected as part of this investigation? ( Number, type (grab/composite), analyses, and locations of samples ):

Five wellhead soil samples will be collected at the locations depicted on the attached soil sample location map. One sample will be collected from each boring at depth of 6-feet bgs. All samples will be field screened and analyzed for the full extend of Table 915-1 compounds. Three flowline samples will be collected at the locations depicted on the attached soil sample location map. All samples will be collected from 3 feet bgs, and all will be analyzed for the full extend of Table 915-1 compounds.

Background soil samples will be obtained in native, undisturbed areas sufficiently away from the operations boundary and investigation area impacted by oil and gas activity. Soil samples will be collected from similar depths and lithologic materials for comparison to delineation and confirmation soil sample results. Background samples will be analyzed for ECMC Table 915-1 SSR parameters and metals.

Included with this submittal is the investigation plan for soil sampling related to the CHEWY B23-25 wellhead cut and cap and flowline removal. The Operator is in the process of scheduling investigation activities, pending site access, at the locations shown on the attached soil sample location maps.

The proposed site investigation date is estimated to commence and be completed in late 3Q2025 or 4Q2025, and schedule will be finalized after landowner consultation. Operator will notify ECMC on a subsequent form submittal if the proposed sampling activities are delayed from the proposed schedule, the reasoning, and an updated timeline.

Pursuant to Rule 913.e, quarterly reporting will continue for the location until data indicates no further action is warranted.
