INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to ECMC Rule 911 a site investigation was conducted pertaining to the MEYER USX CC07-17 wellhead cut and cap and flowline removal. The wellhead was cut and capped per ECMC rules. Approximately 210' of flowline was removed. One grab soil sample from the wellhead excavation floor and one sample at the flowline terminus at the wellhead were collected for during decommissioning. Additionally, soil samples were field screened at the N-E-S-W sides of the wellhead. One (1) soil sample was collected at the flowline terminus at the separator during the facility decommissioning assessment and was reported under Rem. # 31834 (Form 27 Document Number 403679058). Soil samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for the full extent of Table 915-1 compounds for soil quality.

As a result, the associated lab(s) reissued the original reports for this project with additional security measures (Reissued Report).

The reissued report(s) associated with the wellhead site investigation was received directly from Origins laboratory on 2/13/2025 which includes a watermark confirming both the laboratory representative who reissued the report and the date and time of the reissuance. The Reissued Reports are attached to this submission.

The reissued report from Summit Laboratories associated with the active flowline investigation has not been received and data review is pending.

Based on currently available data, this project is not affected by data integrity irregularities pending receipt of Summit laboratory analytical results and is not associated with Operator's data integrity review process and its Rule 525.e. Voluntary Disclosure.
