ALLEGED VIOLATION

Description of Alleged Violation:

Pursuant to Rule 903.d.(1), Venting and Flaring of natural gas represent waste of an important energy resource and pose safety and environmental risks. Venting and Flaring, except as specifically allowed by Rule 903, are prohibited. After the Commencement of Production Operations at an Oil and Gas Location, Venting and Flaring of natural gas produced from any Completed Well is prohibited.

On October 13, 2025, ECMC Staff conducted an audit of Charles P. Dunning, LLC's ("Operator") records for the Jolly-Platts #2 well (API No. 05-001-06060, "Well"), and determined that Operator has been flaring gas while producing the Well. For instance, in September of 2025, Operator reported producing 44 mcf and flared 37 mcf of gas.

Operator flared natural gas, representing a waste of an important energy resource while posing safety and environmental risks, violating Rule 903.

Abatement or Corrective Action Required to be Performed by Operator: _____ Corrective Action Due Date: 11/18/2025

Proper and timely abatement does not preclude the assessment of penalties and an Order Finding Violation.

Operator will immediately cease flaring gas and shut-in the Well.


PENALTY

Penalties for violations alleged in this NOAV will be calculated pursuant to Rule 525, with daily penalties accruing pursuant to Section 34-60-121(1), C.R.S.

ANSWER
