Dear Mr. Smith:

I enjoyed seeing you in September when I was in Denver, and appreciate your delivering my message to Bill Cobb.

Since we have drilled the above captioned well, Bill Cobb has requested that we keep the log and information "tite" while he attempts to make some type of "deal" on the prospect. In consideration of his desires, we have done this as we are for all practical purposes finished with this prospect.

At the same time we are concerned about meeting the requirements of Rule 305 and 306 concerning OGCC Forms 4 and 5 and their timely filing. Early last week we wrote Stuarco Drilling Company requesting that they mail us these forms for us to complete and file in the proper manner. To date we have not received the forms from Stuarco.

From the above discussion you can see that I have two requests, i.e.

(a) Is it permissible for us to withhold the information on this well for a reasonable time in order to help Mr. Cobb in his "deal"?

(b) Would you kindly mail us sufficient copies of Form 4 and 5 in order that we may make the proper and timely filing of these reports.
