Comment: This is a Desktop Environmental Inspection for Remediation Project # 18200, assigned to the Arwood 1 well location located in Kiowa County, Colorado

Form 27-I document no.402642573 received on 03/29/2021, assigned Remediation Project no. 18200 to the Arwood 1 well location, API: 05-061-06742 for the purpose of Decommissioning of Oil and Gas Facility.

Form 6-S, document no. 402742382 was received, 10/08/2021 identifying the cut and cap date for the well as 10/07/2021.

FIR document no. 713600086 conducted on 08/14/2023 assigned the following Corrective Action (CA); It appears there may be impacted soils preventing vegetation establishment at the location including evidence of impacted soil from a potential spill to the east of the wellsite. The soil impacts will need to be investigated and sampled to delineate the vertical and horizontal extent. Operator will need to submit a form 27 to investigate and sample soils per Rule 913. Contact EPS staff for directives.

A follow up FIR document no. 713601656 was conducted on 11/20/2024 assigning the following CA; Comment: There has been no Form 27 submitted for Decommissioning of the Oil and Gas Facility. Corrective Action: Comply with Rule 913.c.(9). Contact EPS Staff for Directives. Due Date: 11/25/2024

In accordance with Rule 913.e. The approved reporting schedule for the project was identified as quarterly (every 90-days). The last Form 27 was received on 07/11/2022, Form 27-S document no. 402924162. The following COA was assigned; Operator will continue quarterly reporting until the site investigation is complete and the implementation schedule can be updated. A supplemental Form 27-S was due on October 9, 2022. At the time of desktop review the Operator is 1,151 days late submitting a quarterly update for remediation project # 18200 in accordance with Rule 913.e.

The Operator shall confirm the presence or absence of impacts to soils in accordance with Rule 913.

This location will remain out of compliance until all Corrective Actions and Conditions of Approval have been met.

Corrective Action:	In accordance with Rule 913.e. the Operator shall submit a Form 27-S to include a current map of the subject location including current excavation limits and/or sample locations, proposed/actual soil boring locations and monitoring well locations. GPS data used to create the map must comply with ECMC Rule 216.
