Hi Mindi, thank you for meeting with me to discuss the Willow Creek surface water sampling. As discussed, Noble is requesting to decrease the frequency of sampling from daily samples to 1 time per week. At this time there will be no change to the location of the samples, they will remain consistent with the eight locations currently being sampled (W002.5, W004, W004.5, and W005 in Willow Creek, and W001, W002, W003, and W006 in Lone Tree Creek).

I will follow up with you next week regarding a rainfall event that may trigger sampling and the equivalent snow event. At this time, we will plan on sampling if we receive a rain event greater than 0.5-inch over a 24-hour period.
