Dear Ms. Greager,

Per our phone conversation on December 31, 2025, this letter is to supplement our earlier letter of November 20, 2025, as well as the Plugging Procedure we submitted on December 30, 2025, regarding Warning Letter # 404428115 for the subject well, Federal (Mitchell) 1-18.

Having heard back from third parties as to why this well was capped four days after plugging, instead of the specified five days, the third-party operator of the plugging operation required his crew to cap the well at four days due to severe weather. If he did not get his crew off location at that time, it would have been a safety hazard for all involved. The operator did, however, confirm there were no bubbles and the plugging was safely and successfully accomplished.

Going forward, Vision Energy will require that its crews, and any third-party crews, wait the minimum five days--or else not more than ninety days--of Rule 434.a.(5) before capping a plugged well, and will note the calculated dates for all parties' reference. Should emergency circumstances like the above scenario require earlier capping, Vision Energy will communicate with ECMC's area engineer at the time of the issue to ensure all parties are on the same page.

If Vision Energy needs to update any forms with this information, Vision Energy kindly requests that it be informed of the specific Document #s so that it may make any necessary updates to the form(s) and this issue may be closed out.
