Plug set at 130 feet near bottom of surface casing. Ten sacks cement on top of plug. Hole was filled to within 20 feet of top with heavy mud and ten sacks cement mixed and poured at top.

Discussed plugging with Compass & was informed that the producing sand in the offset consisted of 10" with questionable Sat. in 4" in this well.
