We have been advised by copy of Carl Houy's letter of August 19, 1963, that you have taken over operations of the Budin well located SW NE, Sec. 12, T-8N, R-55W, Seal Field, Logan County, Colorado; and the State well, located NE SW, Sec. 15, T-8N, R-54W, Logan Field, Logan County, Colorado, effective August 1, 1963.

Although you are on one of our mailing lists, our records do not indicate that you have previously been an operator; therefore, I am enclosing a copy of our Rules and Regulations and several forms, and call your attention to the following:

1. Rule 302, page 10, Designation of Agent, OGCC-Form 1.
  2. Rule 304, page 10, Bonding requirements, OGCC-Form 3 (this will be required for the Budin well, not the State well).
  3. Rule 308, page 12, Operator's Monthly Production Report, OGCC-Form 7.
  4. Rule 309, page 12, Mill Levy Return, OGCC-Form 8.
  5. Rule 311, page 12, Certificate of Clearance, OGCC-Form 10 (Under "Remarks", indicate effective date of change of ownership).
