Ginger,

Attached please find the Surface Owner notice that was sent via certified mail today to HGLN2 Real Estate Investments (surface owner of record with Weld County) for the plug and abandonment ("PA") of the Bohrer Trust 21-19 well. This is currently scheduled for the end of January/beginning of February 2026, but that is subject to change. Of particular note is the necessary appx. 150' radius we will need to PA this well along with unobstructed access. The PA operations require a workover rig and ancillary equipment on location and throughout the process (including smi truck access). The flowline Easement requires us to remove the flowline, which will require surface disturbance appx. Every 50' to dig a 20' X 20' hole, cut the flowline, and remove it with an excavator. If you wish to have us abandon the flowline in place we can do this also. We would cut the flowline, flush it clean with water, and then cap the flowline.

Please review the attached notice (it is identical to the one sent to the PO Box 26 in Mead) with other family members that may be effected by these operations and let me know if you have further questions and/or want to schedule an onsite meeting to discuss.
