Comment This inspection was conducted during the dormant season. Interim areas are well-established with rubber rabbitbrush. Some prickly Russian thistle, an undesirable plant species, is scattered throughout. Weed control is required.
Weed management should be conducted during the time of year when treatment efforts are most effective; a follow-up inspection will be conducted during the 2026 growing season to evaluate weed control efforts at the location. Ongoing weed management is required throughout interim areas at the location.
