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2. Planned Access Roads Continued:

- (2) exceed this amount. This road will be constructed from native borrow accumulated during construction. The average grade will be 7.5%.
- (3) If deemed necessary by the local governmental agencies or their representatives, turnouts will be installed for safety purposes every 0.25 miles or on the top of ridges that will provide the greatest sight distance. These turnouts will be 200' in length and 12' in width and will be tapered from the shoulder of the road for a distance of 50' in length at both the access and outlet ends.
- (4) See item 5 below.
- (5) No culverts will be required along the upgraded mile of jeep trail. No major cuts or fills are necessary for upgrading the access road.
- (6) The existing road has not been center-line flagged.
