Our original Notice of Intention to drill Well No. 69 showed the location to be as follows:
442' FSL, 1250' FWL (SE SW)
Section 2, T9N, R79W
Jackson County, Colorado

Based upon current data obtained from recent drilling, a well at the above location would be high risk because of the oil water contact point. Also, by moving the location to that shown below, we will cross into another fault block. If Well No. 69 is productive at the new location it could provide additional drilling.

Approval is requested to move the location of No. 69 to that shown below:
2200' FSL, 900' FEL (NE SE) Section 2 T9N, R79W Jackson County, Colorado

The new estimated Total Depth of Well No. 69 will be 3850' and we plan to cut 40' of core in the Pierre "B" Sand.
