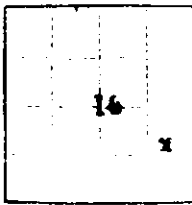

Well was plugged back with 150 sack cement and 23 sack sand. Top of cement plug was 6001 ft. After three unsuccessful attempts to whipstock, well was finally whipstocked at 6187 ft. Deviation of whipstocked hole is approximately 4 degrees.
