This Well is presently perforated from 5740' to 5800' which it is believed limits the production to the Lakota horizon of the Dakota-Lakota reservoir.

We propose to reperformate this well in the interval from 5671' to 5718' in order to test the productivity of the Dakota horizon. This work will be done by killing the well with 11# mud and pulling tubing and perforating casing with swing jet charges.
