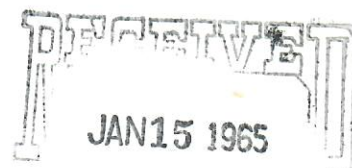

Gentlemen:

We have your letters of January 11th requesting the status of the following wells:


- Conoco Ham 17 No. 2 SW SE, Sec. 17, T10N, R47W, Sedgwick County, Colorado
- Conoco Gov't. 24 No. 3 CSENE, Sec. 24, T10N, R48W, Logan County, Colorado

The drilling of these two wells has not been started due to the soil conditions that are extremely sandy in that area and we have been waiting on moisture which will materially assist in moving in the drilling rig.

We plan, however, to spud Conoco Ham 17 No. 2 by the end of January or, at the latest, the first part of February regardless of the difficulty of moving in the rig.

Subsequent reports will follow as drilling is completed and if further information is necessary prior to that time let us know.
