DETAILS OF WORK

Filled hole with heavy mud. Set bridge plug of lost circulation material and paper and cloth sacks at 460' R.B., ran 30 sacks of cement filling hole from 455' to 400' inside of 10 3/4" surface pipe. Filled surface casing with heavy drilling mud to within 10' of the top of casing set bridge plug of lost circulation material and cemented to top with 5 sacks of cement. Set marker in cement. Surface pipe 2 1/2' below ground level.
