DETAILS OF WORK

Well was plugged and abandoned as follows:

- Plug 1 - 6150-6050 - 35 sacks Monolith regular cement.
- Plug 2 - 5750-5600 - 60 sacks Monolith regular cement.
- Plug 3 - 5030-4930 - 35 sacks Monolith regular cement.
- Plug 4 - 371- 271 - 50 sacks Monolith regular cement.
- Plug 5 - Surface 10 sacks Monolith regular cement.
- Installed marker.

10 joints of 8-5/8" 24# J-55 casing was left cemented at 320.78'KB. Intervals between plugs are filled with mud-laden fluid weighing approximately 9.7 lb/gal.
