Well was spudded at 1 a.m., 5/25/58. Ran 10 jts. 10 3/4" OD, 32.75#, H-40 casing, set at 327' RBM, cemented w/250 sacks of regular cement. Plugged down at 2:50 a.m., 5/26/58, waiting on cement. Nippled up 10 3/4" casing, tested casing w/600# pressure for 30 min. Test O.K., started drilling sand and shale.

Now drilling at 4318', shale.
