The intent of this request is to clear the status of the mineral rights on the lands described below that were included in lease agreement with the Cougar Petroleum Corporation that that have been inactive since July of 1982. Three leases in Logan County, Colorado are involved:

1. Gas & Oil Lease Agreement dated August 21, 1979, containing 321.64 acres, located in Section 2, T10N, R49W, 6th PM, being Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, and S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.
2. Gas & Oil Lease Agreement dated August 21, 1979, containing 160.0 acres located in Section 35, T11N, R49W, 6th PM, being the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35.
3. Oil & Gas Lease Agreement dated June 17, 1980, containing 160. acres located in Section 35, T11N, R49W, 6th PM being the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35.

Under the provisions and terms of the above leases, these Lease Agreements are now considered terminated.

It is requested that a recordable release of these Lease Agreements be furnished for recording at the Office of the County Clerk, Logan County, Sterling Colorado, where the Lease Agreements were recorded.
