Dear Mr. Wells:

We have been trying for several weeks to make contact with Richard Shaheen in regard to two locations and Operator's Monthly Production Reports due from him. Although we were unsuccessful on the first hand, in talking to Ernie Baker he advised that you had done some work for Dick and could possibly help us in these matters.

The two wells concerned are:

1. Frank Svacina Well, C NW NE, Sec. 19, T-8N, R-54W, Logan County, Colorado.
An intention to re-enter was approved October 30, 1961, with no subsequent report. We need a completion report; a Form 10, and production reports or a plugging record.
2. Poe #2 Well, SW SW, Sec. 1, T-3N, R-59W, Morgan County, Colorado. The last word we had on this well was received December 28, 1961, at which time Dick indicated the well would be temporarily abandoned. We need status and such other reports as may have become necessary.
