## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to ECMC Rule 911 a site investigation was conducted pertaining to the HSR-ALBERSTEIN 16-23 wellhead cut and cap and flowline removal. The wellhead was cut and capped per ECMC rules. Approximately 600' of flowline was removed (Form 44 Document Number 403770294).

On 13 December 2023, Eagle Environmental collected five (5) grab soil samples collected at the wellhead excavation (1), flowline directional changes (3), and flowline terminus at the separator (1). Additionally, soil samples were field screened at the N-E-S-W sides of the wellhead. Soil samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for the full extent of Table 915-1, including: TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons), organic compounds in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, EC, SAR, pH, metals, and boron. All samples collected were analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved ECMC laboratory analysis methods.
