Folks,

On March 9, 2026, ECMC Staff Inspected the following Locations/Facilities and observed the following:

Dwinell Tank Battery Facility ID: 465486/Dwinell #1 (057-05129)

- On-going release at the flange where the two (2) 400 bbl produced water fiberglass tanks are manifolded together. (NOTE: This is the same point of failure documented in January 2023, discovered by ECMC Staff, and reported to the Operator discovered again December 11, 2024 and reported to the operator, discovered again on March 9, 2026 and is being reported to the operator via this email

Immediate Current Path Forward:

- Control the Spill/Release and make permanent repairs.
- Operator shall immediately delineate and remediate the extent of impacts.
- Disposition of the fluid impacts shall be documented and provided to ECMC and the BLM.
- Operator shall adhere and comply with the 600, 900, and 1000 Series Rules, among others.
- Operator shall provide an explanation of the tank and pipe setup to the Dwinell #1 (057-05129) making sure all fittings are secured.

Location ID: 450391/Tank Battery ID: 443662, and Yard

- Recent Spill/Release from tank with failed repair first reported to ECMC Environmental on March 5, 2026, by ECMC Compliance Inspection Staff. This was reported to KPK personnel on March 5, 2026 who were in the process of removing fluids and moving soil around.

Immediate Current Path Forward:

- Control the Spill/Release and make permanent repairs.
- Operator shall submit a Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Work plan and immediately delineate and remediate the extent of impacts.
- Disposition of the fluid impacts shall be documented and provided to ECMC and the BLM.
- Operator shall adhere and comply with the 600, 900, and 1000 Series Rules, among others.







Walden Land Treatment Facility ID: 427373.

- Free phase hydrocarbons (oil and paraffin) noted to be pooled in various areas of the land treatment facility. The land treatment facility was not permitted to accept free phase hydrocarbons.
- There did not appear to have been recent activities at the facility that may have been associated with the recent Spill/Release at Location ID: 450391/Tank Battery ID: 443662. This is based on the lack of vehicle traffic pattern near the entrance of the facility.

Immediate Current Path Forward:

- Operator shall submit a Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Work plan and immediately remove the free phase hydrocarbons at an approved facility.
- Disposition of the fluid impacts shall be documented and provided to ECMC.
- Operator shall provide the Location(s) and Facility ID(s) as to where this waste was generated.
- Operator shall adhere and comply with the 900, and 1000 Series Rules, among others.



- Operator shall be compliant with Rule 907, in particular Rule 907.g. Within 45-days of this email.
