Late season grasses have yet to emerge. A site-specific, weed-free seed mix developed in coordination with the Natural Resource Conservation Service District Conservationist, the Las Animas County Extension Service, and the surface owner was used. Weed treatment is being conducted, where needed, to prevent establishment and spread of noxious weeds.
