**INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY**

A site investigation was conducted pursuant to ECMC Rule 911 at the CASTOR PC T1N-R58W-S36 L01 Facility and Tank Battery location.

Grab confirmation soil samples were collected from the produced water vessel(s) excavation, beneath the ground oil tank(s), at the risers for the flowline (s) and dumpline(s) of any separator(s). In addition, the on-site dump lines located between the separator and tank battery were removed by pulling from either end. Soil samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for the full extent of Table 915-1, including but not limited to: TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons) organic compounds in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, and EC, SAR, pH, metals, and boron. All samples collected were analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved ECMC laboratory analysis methods.

After further review the background soil samples collected at BKG01 and BKG02 on 7/31/2024 were determined to be within the historic oil and gas impacted area and will not be used to determine site specific background concentrations.

Twenty background soil samples were collected on 7/31/2024 from an area not impacted by oil and gas development and at depths and lithologies (clayey sands – SC) comparable to those of the confirmation soil samples collected at the location. The samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for Table 915-1 metals and SSR parameters using ECMC approved Methods. Background soil sample analytical results were reported with elevated levels of pH, EC, SAR, Arsenic (As), Barium (Ba), Cadmium (Cd), Lead (Pb) and Selenium (Se).

Confirmation samples SEP-DL 3 Ft, PWV S-5ft and PWV B-6ft at the former CASTOR PC T1N-R58W-S36 L01 tank battery were submitted out of temperature preservation range. Soil will be re-sampled and analyzed for the full Table 915-1 analyte suite at the SEP-DL 3 Ft, PWV S-5ft and PWV B-6ft sample locations at the same depth where the initial confirmation samples were collected in order to confirm initial analytical results. Noble will request a No Further Action (NFA) be granted if the reanalyzed samples comply with the Table 915-1 concentration standard. Background samples will be used to justify elevated concentrations.

Additionally, a supplemental site investigation (SSI) will be completed to collect additional background samples to determine if any future elevated levels of inorganics and metals are attributed to native soil conditions at the site. Background soil samples will be analyzed by a certified laboratory for analysis of metals per ECMC Table 915-1 and soil suitability for reclamation parameters including pH, EC, SAR, and boron. The results of the SSI will be submitted on a subsequent Form 27.

A qualified drilling crew is not immediately available but is expected to commence the work in Q2 2026. Pursuant to Rule 913.e, quarterly reporting will be conducted until closure criteria are achieved for the remediation project. The results of the supplemental site investigation will be submitted on a subsequent Form 27.
